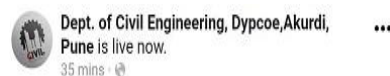
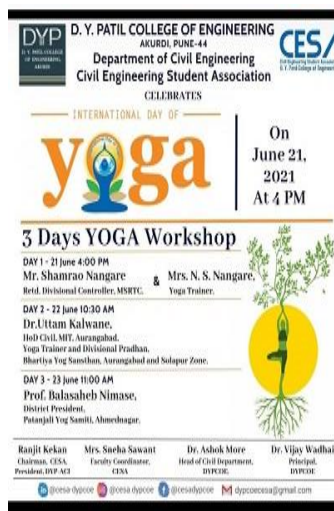
Civil Engineering Students Association, D Y Patil college of Engineering Akurdi had Organized and Successfully Completed 3 days Yoga Workshop.
